### **GEOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION SYSTEMS:**

#### **LONDON BOROUGH OF WANDSWORTH**

Data capture of street furniture for GIS database entailing the positioning of over 75,000 separate items with approximately 1 million attributes of data.

Information was supplied with co-ordinates relative to the Ordnance Survey mapping and issued as digital conversion files for ArcInfo/Oracle in ASCII and TIFF formats.

#### **BOROUGH OF COLCHESTER**

Survey and data capture of grounds maintenance areas requiring the delineation of maintenance plots into highway, housing and recreation cost centres coordinated to Ordnance Survey map sheets with unique plot numbers and cross-referenced to database of area and linear quantities.

The original contract involved the enlargement, half toning and printing of over 320 Ordnance Survey 1:1250 format sheets. The borough was completely re surveyed and updated with submission of all drawings in digital format and the creation of a database suitable for direct input to MapInfo GIS.

#### **LONDON BOROUGH OF CAMDEN**

To facilitate planning and re-design within its controlled parking zones the London Borough of Camden required detailed information on existing road markings and road signs for residents, disabled, doctors, loading, diplomat, business parking bays, taxi ranks, coach and bus stops, parking meters, pay and display machines and lamp columns.

#### **BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

Condition survey of all footpaths, bridleways, stiles, gates and other features associated with public rights of way for Countryside Commission. Data conversion of existing paper records into digital format with feature attributes for GIS.

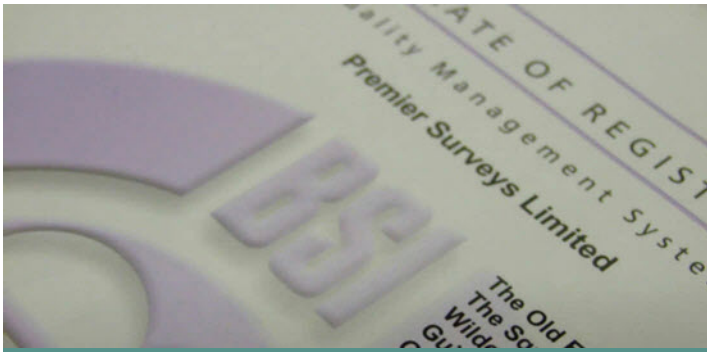
